

Farm Lunch Volunteer

<u>Family Harvest Farm</u> (FHF) is a program of <u>John Muir Land Trust</u> (JMLT) and a place where young adults and adults participate in a local food system that encourages healthy living, nurtures the environment, and grows community. Family Harvest Farm employs transition-age foster youth as apprentices in a hands-on job-readiness program, teaching marketable skills and offering a supportive community.

Volunteer Opportunity Overview: Fresh food and healthy meal preparation are crucial at FHF, and we can't do it without volunteers. All Farm Lunch Volunteers will offer a vegetarian lunch at the farm, and some lead workshops on preparing healthy food.

Responsibilities and Duties:

- Plan for, prepare, and cook healthy, vegetarian lunch for 5-10 people
- Serve lunch on select Tuesdays Fridays at 12:30pm at FHF
- Cook lunch at FHF's rugged kitchen or at your home
- Gather ingredients, needed materials, and integrate FHF produce as available
- Coordinate with FHF staff around scheduling, available produce, and working alongside apprentices
- Assist with kitchen set-up and clean-up
- May facilitate lessons about healthy recipes, eating seasonally, and other topics that can assist apprentices and other community members
- May participate in activities, workshops, and discussions with apprentices

Qualifications:

- Experience and knowledge of cooking fresh or healthy meals, or willingness to learn
- Able to work outdoors, uneven surfaces, and be on your feet
- 18 years of age or attending with a legal guardian
- Good communicator, team player, and able to accept and give clear direction
- Must be vaccinated with the COVID-19 vaccine, and boosters as recommended by health officials, unless a reasonable accommodation is approved
- May be fingerprinted with background check
- May be required to participate in diversity trainings

- Commitment: 1-2 hours on a weekday Tuesday Friday. Lunch is served at 12:30pm
