Significant wetland restoration in the Bay Delta in East Contra Costa County are afoot and nearly complete. This spring, that includes the opening of the restored Pacheco Marsh in Martinez May 3, a significant restoration complete with bridges, kayak launch, trails, and youth education opportunities. And we are just getting started on a second, 600-acre wetland restoration project in the Bay Delta.

Since 1989, JMLT has been a leader in conservation, dedicated to preserving and protecting land and waters that define our community and enrich the natural treasures and quality of life enjoyed by all who call our region home. Now in our 36th year, John Muir Land Trust's mission remains steadfast: protect the irreplaceable places that make the East Bay special. - 1 Franklin Ridge and Pacheco Marsh Dedication and Opening Event May 3, 2025. This event, to be held at Pacheco Marsh in Martinez, includes both a special VIP program with project partners, donors, and elected officials as well as a public opening for all, with trails and activities for families and children to explore all Pacheco Marsh has to offer. Celebrating, dedicating, and officially opening new acquisitions on Franklin Ridge and Pacheco Marsh 400+ acres of permanently protected and newly restored, publicly accessible land the event will include food trucks and activities for family and children. We anticipate more than 500 will attend the program and opening, including individuals from across the county, elected officials, and families.
- Harvest Festival October 25, 2025 This annual tradition, to be held at John Muir Land Trust's Family Harvest Farm in Pittsburg, is a celebration of the season crafted for families and supporters to enjoy including face painting, scavenger hunt, pumpkin painting, puppet show, and more. Family Harvest Farm is a community treasure that that supports the education and employment of local foster youth. This event continues to grow, and last year drew more than 400 children and families from the region.
